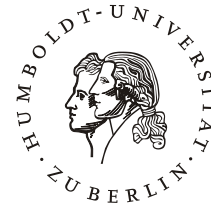

Explanations for Physicians:

If students are unable to attend an examination or must discontinue it for health reasons, they are required under the examination regulations to provide credible evidence of their illness to the responsible Examination Committee (via the Examination Office).

For this purpose, students need a medical certificate that allows the Examination Committee, based on your information as a medical expert, to answer the legal question of whether the student was incapable of taking the examination. Determining whether the documented health impairment justifies non-attendance or discontinuation of the examination is **not** primarily the physician's responsibility; this decision ultimately lies with the examination authority.

Since it is not sufficient for this assessment that you simply certify the student as incapable of taking exams/studying, you are asked to provide brief statements regarding the details listed on the reverse side. You may also confirm the details informally.

Due to their obligation to cooperate, students are generally required to disclose their complaints to determine examination incapacity and, if necessary, to release the treating physician from confidentiality.

This does **not** mean that the physician must disclose the diagnosis itself, but only the physical or psychological effects caused by the illness.
